WHAT DATA WE COLLECT AND WHY (COOKIES POLICY)

Tracking Technologies

We collect personal information that you provide to us. We use cookies* and similar tracking technologies (like web beacons and pixels) to access or store information.

(*) Cookies are pieces of text stored in a particular format within your browser's memory when you visit a website. Websites use cookie data to "cook" the kind of experience they think users should have.

Cookies may be classified as:

- 1. Strictly Necessary Cookies
 - These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the website.
- 2. Performance Cookies
 - These cookies collect information about how visitors use a website, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies a visitor. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. It is only used to improve how a website works.
- 3. Functionality Cookies

These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make (such as your user name, language or the region you are in) and provide enhanced, more personal

features. For instance, these cookies can be used to provide services you have asked for such as watching a video. The information these cookies collect may be anonymised and they cannot track your browsing activity on other websites.

4. Targeting/Advertising Cookies

These cookies are used to deliver adverts more relevant to you and your interests. They are also used to limit the number of times you see an advertisement as well as help measure the effectiveness of the advertising campaign. They are usually placed by advertising networks with the website operator's permission. They remember that you have visited a website and this information is shared with other organisations such as advertisers. Quite often targeting or advertising cookies will be linked to site functionality provided by the other organisation.

We do not require your consent to use Necessary and Performance Cookies. The contexts in which we apply Functionality Cookies and their respective opt-out options are described below. We do not use any Targeting/Advertising Cookies.

Contact Form

We use Formidable Forms to facilitate any query you may wish to make. The only personal data required is your email address, first and last name. Any other personal details you provide is optional. This information and the subject and content of your inquiry are stored in our web's database and are not shared with third parties. You can require the deletion of your personal information at any time selecting the appropriate opt-out option included in the form.

Newsletters

We use Constant Contact for the creation and management of our newsletter. The newsletter subscription form only collects your email address, name and surname. This information is stored within the newsletter management system and not shared with third parties. You can revoke your consent to receive our newsletter at any time, and thus require the deletion of your personal information, by using the unsubscribe link found at the bottom of each email.
